They have a huge selection of movies and TV shows. And they have a lot of movies that Netflix doesn't have. The only downside is that you can't use Hulu on your computer or phone, just your television. Netflix is also a great legal way to get access to movies and TV shows, though not as extensive as Hulu's selection of new releases. If you're a TV buff, Netflix is where it's at. Here are a couple other great streaming services that you might want to check out: Amazon Prime Video and CBS All Access. I haven't used these much, but they have a lot of great looking content, so they might be worth checking out. If you have Amazon Prime, you already have Amazon Prime Video. It has a decent selection of movies and TV shows for free with your membership, as well as many movies and shows that cost money to rent or purchase. CBS All Access is also another great streaming service with a ton of content for free if you're willing to sign up for the extra service. It has a lot of great TV shows and movies. If you don't want to sign up for extra services like Amazon Prime or CBS All Access, but you still want to get movies and TV shows on demand, you can use other streaming services such as YouTube and Vimeo. These services have a selection of free content, but not as extensive as other paid services. Still useful if you're stuck at home without cable or if your ISP is throttling Netflix and Hulu.
